-Suggest that belonging be marked & identified by adding one's name onto property

-When Packing Clothes, please insure that none are profane &/or provocative

-When packing, please remember that it will be cold, so please pack appropriately. And also, space in vehicles is limited... so please only pack for 2 full days!

What NOT to Bring/Do

The following ABSOLUTES are cause for immediate removal from the camp. In extreme cases we may call local law enforcement, along with PARENTS WILL NEED TO PICK UP CHILD:

- No DRUGS
- NO ALCOHOL
- NO VULGAR LANGUAGE
- NO FIRE of any KIND
- NO WEAPONS of any KIND
- NO PUBLIC DISPLAY of AFFECTION (NBC RULE)
- NO GUYS in the GIRLS DORM or GIRLS in the GUYS DORM
- NO PRACTICAL JOKES
- NO STEALING
- NO DESTRUCTION of CAMP PROPERTY

- CELL PHONES can ONLY be used during the time to & from the Retreat, and during FREE TIME. All other times (during teachings, camp time, meal times, game times, etc. Cell Phones must be given to Retreat Leader to be held or left in vehicle

Purpose

Our heart at this year's RETREAT, is to challenge, encourage and equip those who attend, to have ANCHORED HOPE.

Understanding Anchors:

1. The rougher the weather, the more important the Anchor is.
2. Anchors help prevent a ship from being wrecked & destroyed.
3. Anchors help stabilize a ship
4. Anchors help maintain a ship's progress
5. Anchors must be secure to the ship

During the time we live in, this understanding of an Anchor is very fitting. Unlike a ship though, that is anchored downward, we are to be anchored upward, in the Hope found only in Christ.

Departure & Arrival Plans:

Please plan accordingly concerning when to be dropped off for the Retreat, & when to be picked up.

Arrangements should be made prior to the day of the RETREAT, to arrive at church by ensure you are on time to church, so that we can leave at a decent time.

So, please pack the night(s) before the retreat, and make the proper arrangements

The sooner our group leaves, the better! Think about others, in this aspect... in the sense... don't make the whole group wait for YOU! Also, consider...if the group arrives late... NO DINNER will be PROVIDED on FRIDAY NIGHT! Please don't be the reason for everyone NOT EATING!

Also... you will arrive back at your church at approximately 1200pm on Sun (March 7th)

Please make the proper arrangements to be picked up by your parents.
