## Purpose:

The heart at this year's RETREAT, is to challenge, encourage and equip those who attend, to live a life that would be FOR THE GLORY of God.

For many Youth, they are at an age, and live in a world, that they probably are: striving, participating, and living "FOR OTHERS". In the sense that, some youth are trying to fit in with their peers, others are trying to make their parents happy, and some are just thinking about themselves. In some aspects, those are good... others, not so good. However, in light of ETERNITY... striving, participating, and living for anyone but God, is "meaningless".

For us as Christians, we are called to live differently, and even have a different mind-set. This years Retreat, our prayer is to look at what and how our Christian lives should and need to be living... and that is FOR THE GLORY of GOD!

## Your Role Before that Retreat:

**1. Pray:** Please pray daily for your youth & those who will attend

*- For their walk w/ the Lord, for faithfulness to home & school, finances*

*-For them to INVITE people to JESUS, BELIEVE in JESUS, & a heart to SERVE JESUS through the HOLY SPIRIT*

**2. Invite & Inform:** Please contact & talk to youth as well as parents

*- Be challenged to not only inform your Youth Group, but take an active role personally, to let the Parents know what is going on.*

**3. Serve:** Get involved in the Youth's lives so that they would desire to spend a weekend w/ Jesus & you

*- See ways in which you can pour into these youth so that they can BELIEVE in JESUS through your life. We need to exemplify & live out this theme of FOR THE GLORY before the Retreat starts!*

*-Also, prepare to drive a car in the snow(whether that means yours or someone else's, make arrangements to be prepared to drive)*

## Your Role During the Retreat

**1. Pray:** Please be in constant prayer during the Retreat

**2. Lead:** Be watchful over all the youth... not as a hireling... but a shepherd who loves the sheep

*- Keep an eye on your youth, and make sure their "environment" at the Retreat is one that isn't distracting to what God wants to do and speak to them.*

*-Be watchful for all the Youth that attend, not just your own.*

## What is Needed Before the Retreat from your church:

### 2. Funds Collected

-Cost of Retreat is \$130

- There will be an online payment options, but we **STRONGLY ENCOURAGE**, to collect all your groups funds, and just write one check out to Calvary Chapel Santa Clarita

### 3. Shirt Sizes must be turned in by Feb 13<sup>th</sup>

-Shirts will be ordered in Girls & Guys cut. Please indicate which you prefer, per shirt

### 4. Team Break-Up:

-Please split your group into 4 equal teams (including all leaders) if your church has 15 or more attending. If less than 15, please split your Group into 2 equal teams.

-This years colors are GREEN, BLUE, RED and YELLOW. Please encourage your youth to buy (or your church can provide), something to REPRESENT their TEAM (bandanas, shirts, beanies, hats, etc)

### 5. Insure that all leaders attending have passed a Background Check

-Either through your church, or CC Living Water, we are asking that a background check be run on all leaders attending

**6. Certificate of Liability Insurance:** contact your church insurance and send a copy to **akemi.deherrera@gmail.com**

### 7. Arrive @ Retreat on Time:

- make best possible arrangements to be at Camp Cedar Crest **NO LATER** then 5pm (dinner will be served @ this time.) 1<sup>st</sup> Session will begin promptly @ 6pm. Suggested arrival time is 4pm.

## What is Needed Once Youth Group Arrive at the Retreat:

1. Once your group arrives, we ask that you send a Group Leader to the "registration tables", where you will receive your Cabin Location, Retreat Shirts, & Retreat Badges
2. Please turn in: MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS, FINAL count of your Group, & Final balance of Deposits
3. Unload & head to Dinning Hall

## RETREAT ABSOLUES:

The following ABSOLUTES are cause for immediate removal from the camp. In extreme cases we may call local law enforcement as well:

## Medication & Food:

If any child needs a special diet, please let us know before the retreat, so we can make proper arrangements.

We will have a few medical supplies for any injuries, that should help stabilize anyone, if any injury occurs, until the Ambulance/Parents can arrive at Camp Cedar Crest.

If any of your Youth have a problem and need medicine, they will need to come with their youth leader to receive any over the counter medication. Please insure that they are not allergic to the medicine.(have a list of any over the counter medicine your youth may be allergic too)
